

Publications Copyright Agreement

The National Association for Surface Finishing (NASF) is pleased to have the opportunity of publishing the above named contribution on an exclusive basis.

Because of the changes in the copyright laws, effective for material published on or after January 1, 1978, it is necessary for the Association to obtain a release from authors for all materials published. To this end we ask you to grant us all rights, including subsidiary rights, for your contribution. Your signature on this agreement as the Author expresses your concurrence in the terms of publications of your contribution.

In consideration of the NASF publication of the Author's above identified contribution, the Author and NASF agree that:

1. Consent to Publish. The Author grants and assigns exclusively to NASF for its use any and all rights of whatsoever kind or nature now or hereafter protected by the Copyright Laws of the United States and all foreign countries in all languages in and to the above identified contribution, including all subsidiary rights. The Author warrants that the contribution is original and that he or she has full power to make this grant. It is understood that the Author will receive no royalty or other monetary compensation from NASF for use of the material. NASF will publish the material at its own cost and expense. It is understood that the NASF will exercise its prerogative with respect to editing submitted manuscripts.

2. Author Guarantees. The Author guarantees that the above identified manuscript contains no matter libelous or otherwise unlawful or which invades individual privacy or which infringes any proprietary right. The Author guarantees that the material has not been previously published or submitted elsewhere. Otherwise, the Author guarantees that if the material has been previously published, in whole or in part, permission has been obtained for publication by NASF and the Author will submit copy of the permission release and copy for credit lines with his manuscript.

3. Republication. NASF grants to the Author the right of republication of the material in any book of which he or she is the author or editor, subject to requesting NASF authorization from the publisher and giving proper credit to the original NASF publication of the article.

Please sign and date this agreement and return one copy to the NASF immediately and retain one copy for your files.

The Author signs and accepts responsibility for releasing the material on behalf of any and all coauthors.

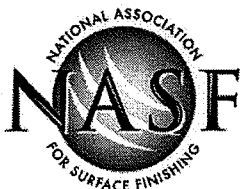
